

Feathers



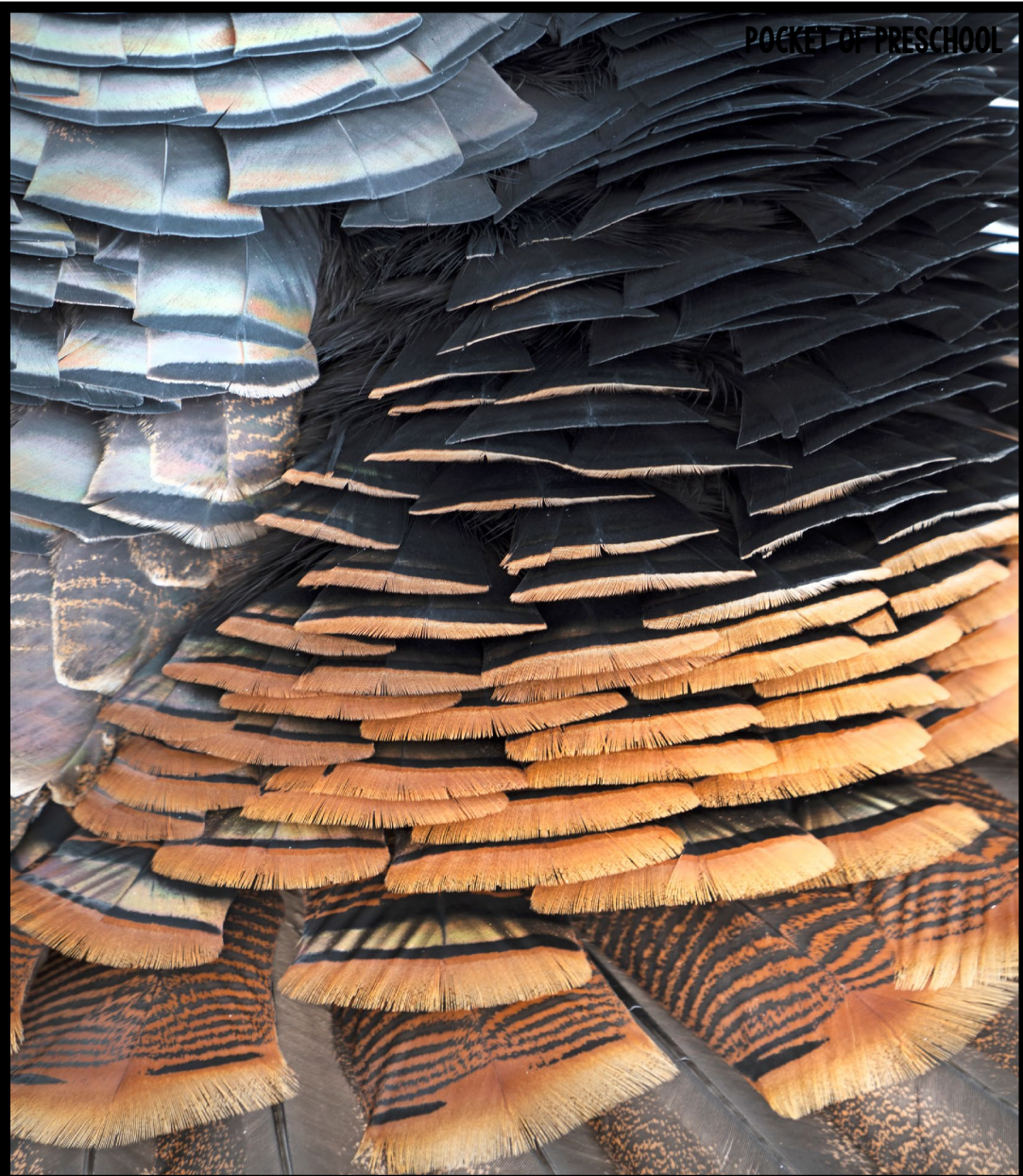
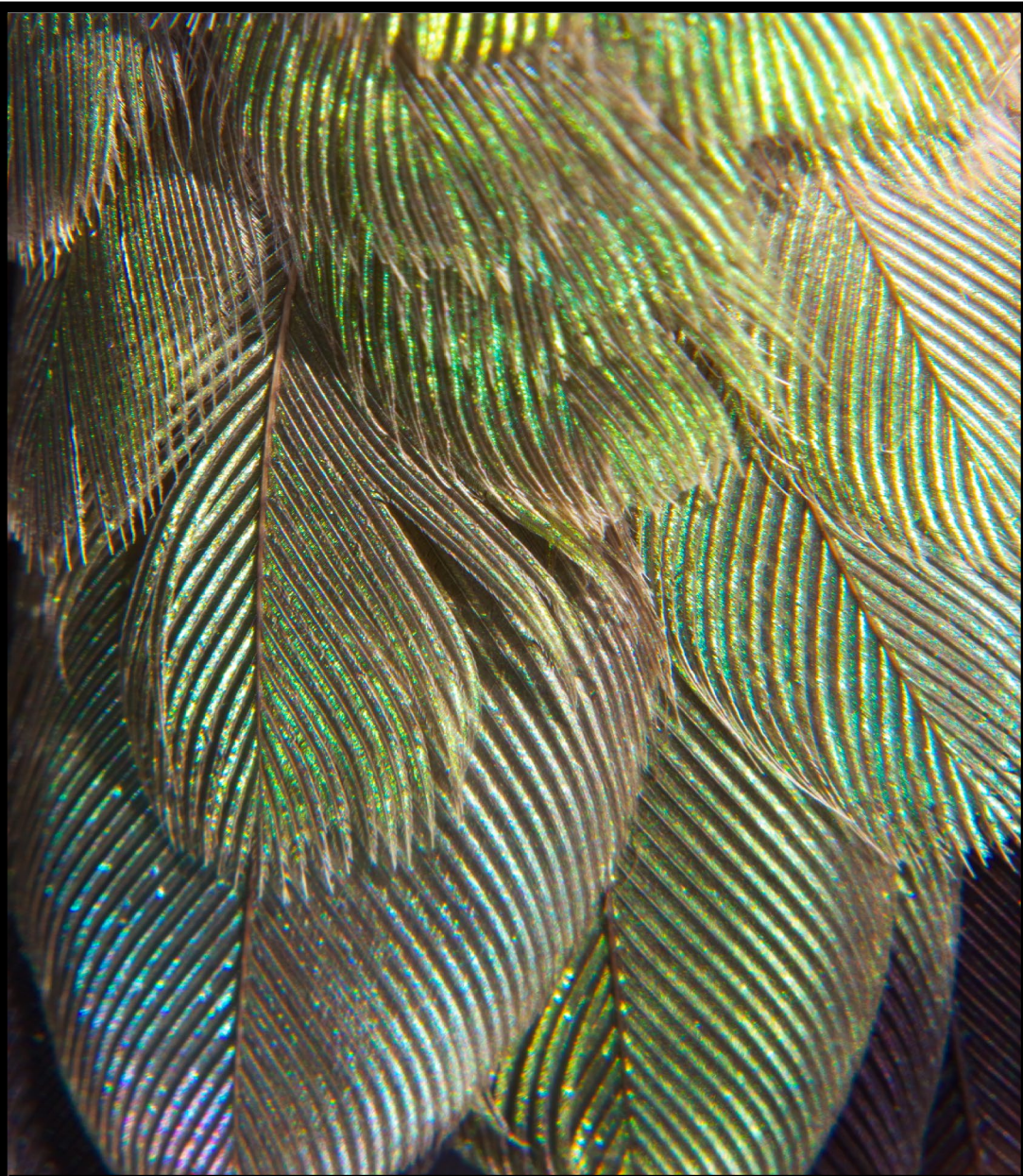
All birds have feathers! Feathers are used to help birds fly, hide, keep warm, stay dry, or attract a mate.

BEAKS



Cone Shaped Beaks

- cracking seeds
- like nutcracker or pliers
- goldfinch, parrot, cardinals



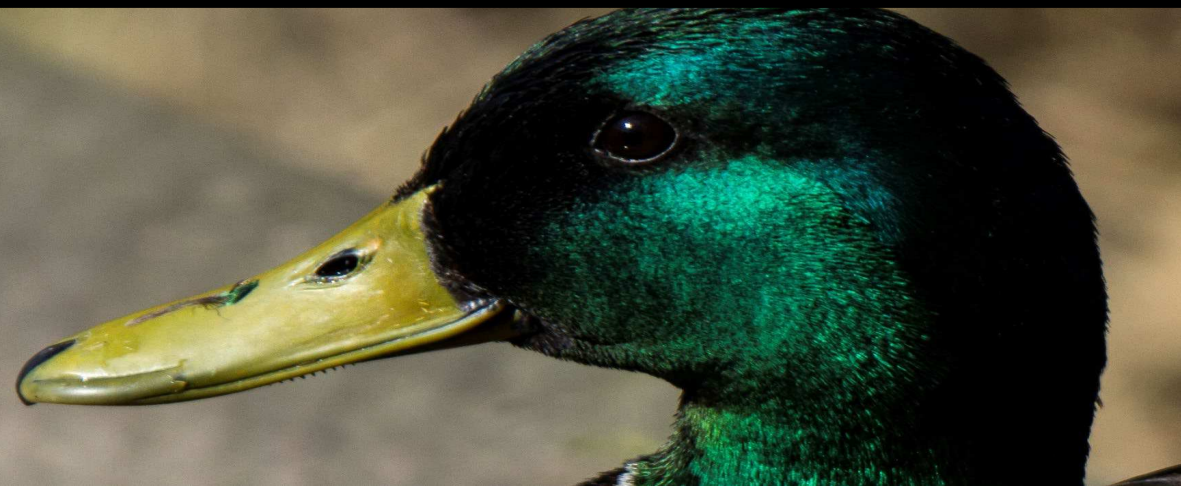
Short and Wide Beak

- catch bugs
- like a pair of tweezers or clothespin
- sparrow, swallows, bluebird



Long and Strong Beak

- hammer holes into trees
- like a chisel or hammer
- woodpecker



Scoop Beak

- scoop up fish, plants in water
- like a strainer or spoon
- pelican, duck, spoonbill



Tube Beak

- drink nectar from a flower
- like a straw
- hummingbird



Hooked Beak

- tear and rip meat
- like a knife and fork or scissors
- eagles, hawks, owls
