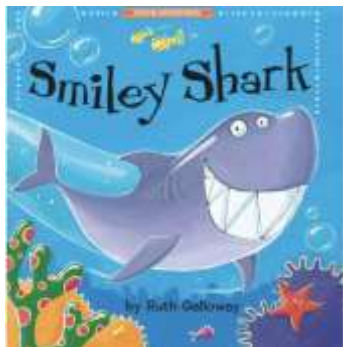


Deep Sea Wonder

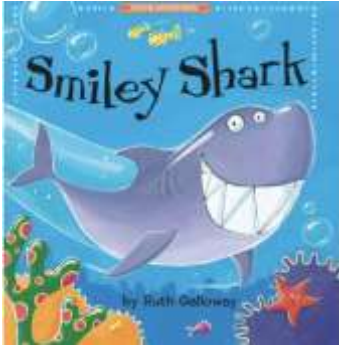
